Since 2000, the reported rate of syphilis has been on the rise.



SYPHILIS IS AN STI

Syphilis is spread through unprotected sex and pregnancy.



SYPHILIS IS ON THE RISE

Currently, there is 1 new case every 20 minutes.



YOU MAY BE AT A GREATER RISK

Syphilis is more of a risk for some, including men, people aged 20-34 and over 55 years, men who have sex with men, and African Americans.

YOU MAY NOT KNOW YOU'RE INFECTED

Early symptoms include a sore on the mouth or genitals and a rash.



TALK TO YOUR PARTNER

Make sure you are both STI-free before having sex.



PROTECT YOURSELF

Condomless sex is never safe. PrEP does not protect against syphilis.



GET TESTED TODAY

Talk to your doctor about getting tested regularly.



SYPHILIS IS TREATABLE

Your doctor may prescribe antibiotics if needed.
